Itinerary

Day 1: COCHIN - NEW YORK

Fortune Tours Grand USA Tour begins. Assemble at Kochi International Airport at 01.00 hrs. Check-in starts at 01.20 hrs. After emigration and customs formalities Emirates Flight EK 533 departs to Dubai at 04.30hrs and arrives at Dubai International at 06.50 hrs. Later connect Emirates Flight EK 201 to New York and arrive John. F. Kennedy International Airport, New York at 14.25 hrs.

Welcome to New York City! New York is the most populous city in the United States and a global power city and home to the headquarters of the United Nations. Several sources have ranked New York, the most photographed city in the world. On arrival you will proceed to your hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Hotel. Fairfield Marriott NJ or similar in New York.

Day 2: NEW YORK CITY TOUR

Cruise Tour to Liberty Island to visit Statue of Liberty

Today begin your memorable journey through the United States of America. Start your day with a buffet breakfast at the hotel and soak in the sights of this magnificent New York City on a guided city tour. The sightseeing will start from the USA's famous landmark "Statue of Liberty". We will take a ferry ride from New Jersey to Liberty Island via Ellis Island to view the iconic and prestigious Statue of Liberty and a spectacular view of the New York City skyline. The copper statue of Liberty, designed by Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi, a French sculptor, was built by Gustave Eiffel and dedicated on October 28, 1886, as a gift to the United States from the people of France as a symbol of Freedom and Democracy. The statue was a welcoming sight to immigrants arriving from abroad with an overall height of 305 feet and 6 inches and the total weight of 225 tons. There are seven rays on her crown, one for each of the seven continents.

New York City Tour

Later we take a ferry from Liberty Island to Battery Park in New York. We explore the beautiful city of New York, see Downtown Wall Street, Central Park 5th Avenue, Midtown Manhattan, Rockefeller Centre, the headquarters of the United Nations, Brooklyn Bridge, Trump Hotel and lower Manhattan. Later we will spend some time at "Ground Zero" or 9/11 Memorial Plaza. The 9/11 Memorial Plaza is an 8-acre Park, where the World Trade Center Twin Towers once stood. The foundations of the Twin Towers have been converted into reflecting pools and the surrounding area is now a grove of trees. Here we visit the one World Trade Centre and Oculus, also called the World Trade Center Transportation Hub, the brilliantly white, space-aged looking structure.

Unforgettable Moments in One World Observatory.

After lunch, we visit the One World Trade Center is the main building of the rebuilt World Trade Center complex in Lower Manhattan, New York City. One World Trade Center is the tallest building in the United States, the tallest building in the Western Hemisphere, and the seventh-tallest in the world. One World Observatory is at the top of the One WTC. The Observatory is located on the 100th, 101st, and 102nd floors and it offers views of New York City's iconic sights, surrounding waters and skyline. Later you will have a buffet local dinner at the restaurant.

Visit Times Square and be amazed by the life and light of the New York City.

New York City that never sleeps. After dinner, you visit Times Square and be amazed by the life and light of the New York City at night. This is one of the most famous intersections in the world. During the 364 days of the year, Times Square is almost as crowded, as street performers put on shows and visitors from around the world gawk at the millions of lights that adorn the neon billboards. It offers non-stop events and activities that reflect the spirit of the Big Apple and you will never far from the festivals, parades, entertainment, major sporting events and celebrations of art and culture. Free Time at very live Time Square. Later you will back to the hotel. Overnight stay in Hotel Fairfield Marriott NJ or similar in New York.

Day 3: NEW YORK - WASHINGTON D.C.

After an American breakfast at the hotel check out and drive to Washington D.C.Washington DC is the United States' capital city on the Potomac River, bordering the states of Maryland and Virginia. On arrival you will meet the guide and visit the major sights of Washington D.C. like the White House, Capitol Hill, the home of the United States Congress, and the seat of Supreme Court, Lincoln Memorial, Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial, WW2 Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Martin Luther Memorial, FBI building and Washington National Cathedral, Pentagonetc.

Visit Smithsonian National Air and Space Museums

After lunch visit the Smithsonian Air and Space Museum. The National Air and Space Museum of the Smithsonian holds the largest collection of historic aircraft and spacecraft in the world. On July 20, 1969, astronauts Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin landed in the Lunar Module Eagle and became the first humans to step foot on the lunar surface while astronaut Michael Collins orbited above inside the Command Module, Columbia. Here we can see the collection of objects from that historic mission. The Human Spaceflight collection from the first U.S. manned Mercury missions through Apollo, the Space Shuttle, and the International Space Station...etc. It was established in 1946 and the museum saw approximately 6.7 million visitors, making it the fifth most visited museum in the world. Tonight, enjoy an Italian/ Chinese buffet dinner and later transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay in Sheraton College Park or similar in Washington DC.

Day 4: WASHINGTON - NIAGARA

Hershey's Chocolate Factory visit

After an American breakfast at the hotel, check out and drive to Harrisburg. On arrival, we visit Hershey's Chocolate Park. Hershey's is widely popular for Chocolate -Themed Park in United States. Hershey's chocolates were founded by candy magnate Milton S. Hershey. Ride a train that follows the journey of Chocolate Tour, an attraction that allows visitors to trace the production from cocoa bean to the final product. The carriage takes you through a replica factory and explains what goes into making chocolate so tasty. Enjoy a taste of the chocolate after the tour. This ride is an original attraction, showing a simulation of the chocolate-making process. Free time to buy Hershey's Chocolate to your home. Then you will continue to drive through the lush green valley and enjoy some stunning scenery on the way as you arrive at Niagara Falls, the natural wonders of the world. On arrival, you will transfer to the hotel. Evening free time to view the Falls. Dinner and overnight stay in Wyndham Garden Niagara Fallsview or similar in Niagara.

Day 5: NIAGARA FALLS

Maid of the Mist Boat Ride to Niagara Falls

After the continental breakfast proceed to the natural wonders east of the Mississippi, the Niagara Falls, the greatest. The majesty, colors and roar of one of the Great Lakes dropping into the next are impossible to describe. See both the Horseshoe, American and Bridal Veil Falls this morning as you cruise the thrilling the Maid of the Mist boat ride for an unbelievable view of all the three Falls(seasonal). The boat starts at a calm part of the Niagara River, near the Rainbow Bridge, and takes you to the American and Bridal Veil Falls, then into the dense mist of spray inside the curve of the Horseshoe Falls. Feel the mist as this boat takes you to the base of the Horseshoe Falls. Rainbows are usually visible day and night. Freshen up after your damp ride.

The Cave of the Winds

After the lunch, the Cave of the Winds trip takes you closer to the waters of Niagara Falls than you thought possible. A journey that takes you deep below and behind the heart of the Niagara Falls. You will descend 175 feet (53 meters) deep by elevators through bedrock to tunnels that lead to viewing portals which are one-third of the way behind the massive Niagara Falls. Then, clad in a bright yellow poncho and wearing the special footwear provided, you follow a tour guide over a series of wooden walkways to the famous "Hurricane Deck". The rushing waters loom above you, dousing you with a generous spray as you face the thundering Falls head-on. Enjoy your time in Niagara Falls with the breathtaking Falls, Hurricane Decks, Cave of the Winds and the Maid of the Mist and more, a Niagara Falls vacation is the ultimate. Later transfer to hotel and free time at the hotel.

Niagara Falls in Lights

Later after dinner you will get an opportunity to witness the Niagara Falls in Lights. Niagara Falls is transformed into incredible, multi-colored water and light masterpiece. Special lights are housed in the Illumination Tower with new LED lighting technology at the brink of the falls. The LED lighting provides programmable lighting and a wider spectrum of color. Together, these lights work to create a breathtaking view of the Niagara Falls. Later return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Wyndham Garden Niagara Falls view or similar in Niagara.

Day 6: FLY TO ORLANDO

Visit Kennedy Space Center (NASA)

Today after continental breakfast we depart to Orlando by flight. Orlando is a city in the state of Florida and the county seat of Orange County. Located in Central Florida, it is the sixth-largest metropolitan area in the Southern United States. On arrival in Orlando airport, you will transfer to Kennedy Space Center (NASA) Kennedy Space Center (KSC) is named after President John F. Kennedy, who famously declared in 1961 that the United States would put an astronaut on the moon. You will transfer to an air-conditioned motor coach and go beyond the Kennedy Space Center Bus Tour with the Explore Tour, making several stops to capture photo opportunities and view icons of NASA spaceflight operations. Also visit US Astronaut Hall of Fame, Heroes, and Legends, I max Theatre, Rocket Garden, Astronaut Encounter...etc. and later transfer to the hotel.

Dinner and overnight stay in Hotel Residence Inn Marriott or similar in Orlando.

Day 7: MAGIC KINGDOM

The land was home to attractions such as Mickey's Country House, Minnie's Country House, The Barnstormer at Goofy's Wiseacre Farm, and Donald's Boat. Believe in make-believe! Immerse yourself in a magical 3D adventure starring Mickey in Mickey's Philharmagic, sail on a boisterous journey in "Pirates of the Caribbean", Rockets into another galaxy in the Space Mountain, plunge five stories in Splash Mountain, take a tumble through the gold mining town in Big Thunder Mountain Rail Road.

You see the dazzling and delightful parade as it makes its way around the park. Move your feet to the vibrant Disney music and set your imagination soaring and witness the light and sound shows and fireworks in Disney Land and say goodbye to your favorite animated friends and Walt Disney's Magic Kingdom and return to the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Hotel Residence Inn Marriott or similar in Orlando.

Day 8: FLY TO LAS VEGAS

The Hoover Dam continues to play an essential role for the surrounding economies and their inhabitants, providing water to 8,000,000 people in Arizona, California, and Nevada and especially to Las Vegas. During this tour of the Hoover Dam, enjoy the best views from both the Arizona and Nevada sides of the Colorado River. Pat Tillman Memorial Bridge also the major attraction, offers the highest accessible overlook of the Dam and Black Canyon.

Visit Grand Canyon, the natural wonders of the world

Later you will transfer to the Grand Canyon, another natural wonder of the world. The Grand Canyon is a steep-sided canyon carved by the Colorado River in the state of Arizona in the United States. Nearly two billion years of earth's geological history have been exposed as the Colorado River cut their channels through layer after layer of rock while the Colorado Plateau was uplifted. The Grand Canyon is 446 km long, up to 29 km wide and attains a depth of over a mile. Several recent studies support the hypothesis that the Colorado River established its course through the area about 5 to 6 million years ago. Since that time, the Colorado River has driven the down-cutting of the tributaries and retreat of the cliffs, simultaneously deepening and widening the canyon. For thousands of years, the area has been continuously inhabited by Native Americans, who built the settlements within the canyon and its many caves.

You will get a chance to visit Grand Canyon West Rim with Skywalk. A breathtaking view of Grand Canyon from a manmade glass bridge will serve up quite a thrill as you take in the views of the Canyon. The Grand Canyon West Rim 3,500 plus feet high above the Colorado River by taking a stroll on the world-famous Skywalk. Later transfer to the hotel. Later proceed to the hotel. Dinner and overnight stay in Hotel Luxor or similar in Las Vegas.

Day 10: LOS ANGELES

After an American buffet breakfast at hotel, check out and drive to Los Angeles, the city of entertainment in the United States. Los Angeles is the second-most populous city in the United States situated in Southern California nicknamed the "City of Angels". Take in the excessive wealth and look for celebrity sightings as you drive by the homes of the rich and famous stars like MerlyneManroe and Charle Chaplin...etc

Visit Hollywood and Entrance to Dolby Theater of Oscar Academy Awards Oscar Award

You will have entrance to the Dolby Theatre, which hosts the Oscar Awards. Since its opening on November 9, 2001, the Dolby theater has hosted the Academy Awards ceremonies. You will walk through the legendary star-studded Hollywood's Walk of Fame and you can match your hand prints and footprints to those of Hollywood Stars, embedded in cement in front of TCL Chinese Theatre and see the famous handprints and footprints of stars like Michal Jackson, Merlyn Monroe, Steven Spielberg, John Lenon.....etc. Then visit the Egyptian and El Capitan, both of which are flamboyant icons from Hollywood's glitzy past. And Fisherman's market, Griffith Museum, Downtown Los Angeles skyline, Echo Park...etc. Dinner and overnight stay in Park Inn Radisson by Covina or similar in Los Angeles.

The company reserves the right to postpone or cancel any of the tours advertised, without assigning any reason. In this case, amount paid by the passengers will be refunded in full and no compensation claim will be entertained. Due to certain unavoidable circumstances, the company reserves the right to change/modify/ vary and alter the tour itinerary. In such changes, compensations or claims for refund by the passengers will not be entertained by the company for limitation and also for the non-availability of certain services with entry tickets, restaurants, sightseeing, shopping etc. even though included in the tour itinerary. For Single Passenger traveling without family have to share a room either on a twin or triple sharing basis (Roll away bed) depending on the booking. If we do not have another single passenger to share the room, Single Supplement with additional cost is applicable. The tariff of the tour quoted is calculated as per the rates prevailing at the time of quoting it. The Company reserves the right to change the tariff in the event of modification/alteration/change/variation in the said rates before the date of departure. Tour tariff is based on departure from Cochin unless specifically mentioned. Tourists boarding flights at places other than Cochin have to pay the entire airfare difference and bear and pay any other additional expenses including airport transfers, hotel stay, etc. on that account. The company takes care to select hotels and book the same on behalf of tourists at convenient locations subject to availability. In the computerized reservation system of Airlines seats once reserved cannot be changed. Tour participants will have to travel by the same seat provided by the Airline. Any damage caused to the hotel rooms or coach during your stay shall be payable by the passengers. Fortune Destination Management India Pvt Ltd will not be held responsibility for the same. There are no refunds for any services, i.e. meals, sightseeing, flight delay or cancellation of flight, etc. not utilized on the tour. The Company shall not accept any liability or responsibility for any damages, loss, injury, accident, death, natural calamity, delay, breakdown or irregularity that may occur in carrying out the tour arrangement.
